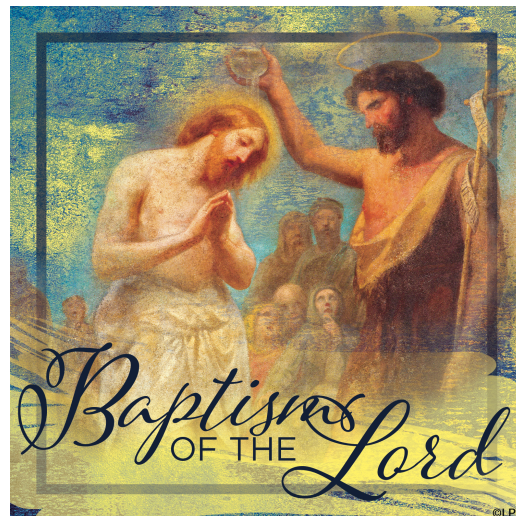
PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

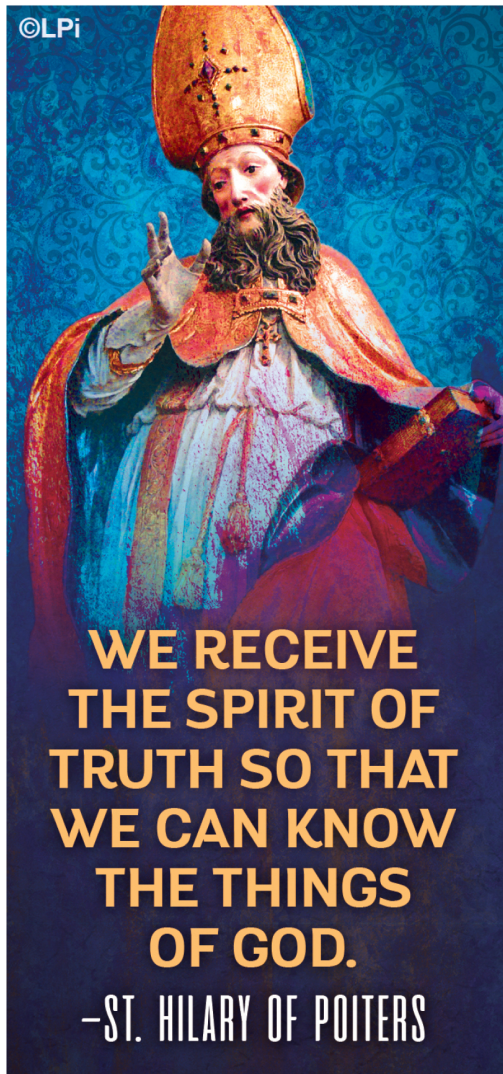
LIVE THE LITURGY
